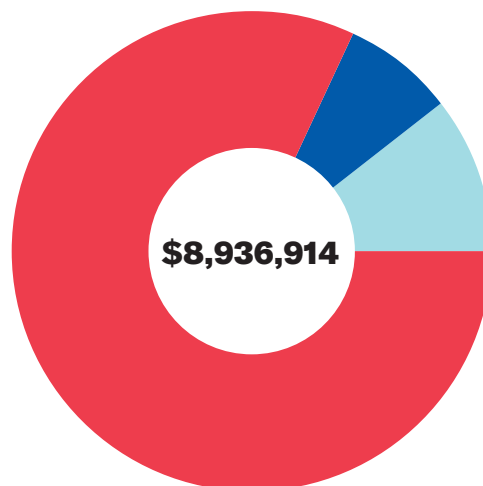
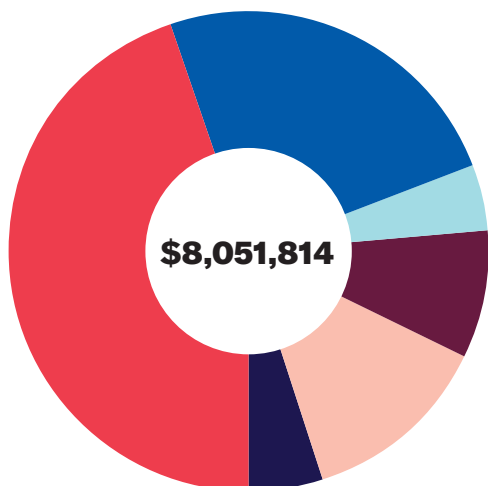


Financial Summary
