Situation Summary and Health and Safety Briefing (for briefings or transfer of command): Recognize potential incident Health and Safety Hazards and develop necessary measures (remove hazard, provide personal protective equipment, warn people of the hazard) to protect responders from those hazards.

Salem Halloween 2013 will attract approximately 100,000 people many of whom will be dressed in costumes and enjoying themselves at a peaceful family-friendly event. However, as in past years, there are always those individuals in costume or normal dress that will seek to disrupt the event by whatever means possible. Typically, it's a result of their level of sobriety, but also may involve gang related activity from gangs who seek to use the event as a means to commit crimes.

The top priority for all law enforcement officers is to quickly identify and remove potential hazards of all types during the event to that we may assist Salem PD in achieving the goal of maintaining a family-friendly atmosphere for all to enjoy.

Safety Message:

- **Dangerous Weapons:** All NEMLEC personnel shall wear appropriate soft body armor. Always be aware of your own firearm at all times, since you will be working in a crowded environment.
- **Nighttime operations and traffic:** At the discretion of the NEMLEC Commander all personnel may have to wear a reflective vest to mitigate the dangers of nighttime operations.
- **Civil Unrest, Active Shooter, Explosive Device, HAZMAT release, bad weather or other emergency situations that arise:** Should a potential large-scale incident occur, the Event Incident Commander may request the NEMLEC Commander to rally all NEMLEC Tactical Resources to report immediately to the Rally Point located at the Century Bank, 37 Charter Street, where the NEMLEC Commander will assemble and make ready the appropriate response

7. Current and Planned Objectives:
 Top priorities for this event are: Life Safety of responders and public, maintain a stabile event, and protect property and the environment.
 The primary objectives for this event are:

- Maintain a family-friendly atmosphere for the enjoyment of all persons attending the event.
- Quickly identify and remove persons whose intent is disruptive or criminal in nature.
- Quickly identify and mitigate hazardous conditions and notify appropriate resources for assistance.
- Strive to maintain a professional demeanor when interacting with all persons regardless of their actions. (Everyone has a camera phone and you don't want to be on YouTube or the news later.)
- Enforce the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; and assist Salem PD Officers as needed while enforcing the Enhanced Safety Zone Ordinances in the 5 Division assignments.
- Use the appropriate level of force when necessary to take to quell a disturbance or take a person into custody.
- All Arrests are to be taken by a Salem PD Officer. (Serious crimes will require a written report from the NEMLEC officer.)
- As directed by the Division Commander at approximately 22:15 to 22:30 Hours move all persons from the downtown area.

8. NEMLEC Areas of Operation:

- SWAT will maintain an Immediate Action Team in an unmarked SWAT van for deployment at the discretion of the Event Commander and the NEMLEC Commander.
- At the request of the Event Commander the NEMLEC Commander will assign SWAT personnel as needed to assist RRT officers in each Division.
- At the request of the Event Commander the NEMLEC Commander will assign RRTT personnel in small squads as needed to each of the 5 Divisions.
- At the request of the Event Commander the NEMLEC Commander will assign K9 teams to each of the 5 Divisions.
- At the request of the Event Commander the NEMLEC Commander will assign mountain teams to each of the 5 divisions or utilize these resources as mobile field forces.
- At the request of the Event Commander the NEMLEC Commander may assign the Motor Unit to operate as Mobile Field Force squads to assist in crowd control, escorting public safety vehicles in and around the 5 Divisions, and in moving persons from the downtown area when the event shutdown order is given by the Event Commander.
- **Civil Unrest, Active Shooter, Explosive Device, HAZMAT release, bad weather or other emergency situations that arise: Should a potential large-scale incident occur, the Event Incident Commander may request the NEMLEC Commander to rally all NEMLEC Tactical Resources to report immediately to the Rally Point located at the Century Bank, 37 Charter Street, where the NEMLEC Commander will assemble and make ready the appropriate response capability to assist Salem PD.**
