

RE: SWAT Call-Out Lafayette Ave Haverhill

On Friday March 27, 2015 the NEMLEC SWAT Team was activated to assist the Haverhill Police Department with serving a high risk search warrant. The team was instructed to stage at the Haverhill Police Department Bailey Blvd. at 0430 hours. Upon my arrival at the staging area I met with Detective Dana Burrill who informed me that as a result of a narcotics investigation he had obtained a No-Knock night time search warrant (Haverhill District Court docket for Lafayette Avenue The search warrant also included the basement and attic. The main target of the investigation is According Det. Burrill, I involved in the sale and distribution of both heroin and cocaine. Det. Burrill also stated that an undercover operation conducted by the ATF in October 2014 resulted in three long arms being purchased out of Lafayette Ave. It is believed that is in possession of a firearm. A second male subject, also resides at Lafayette Ave. and is believed to be involved in dealing narcotics. Det. Burrill also indicated that the residences in the first floor apartment are not involved in the narcotics operation.

After providing the case background to the team Sgt. Fay went over the operational plan for the warrant service. Sgt. Fay had met with both Det. Burrill and Sgt. Buckley on Thursday March 26th and obtained all the pertinent information to complete the operations order. The mission called for the SWAT team to conduct a dynamic entry, the Alpha team would be the primary entry team making entry on the main door (side 1) moving up a flight of stairs then breaching the second floor apartment door. The Bravo Team would make entry on a rear door (side 4) move up a flight of stairs and conduct a

breach and hold on the second floor apartment. The Delta Team would secure the perimeter of the home.

It was at this time the team leaders and vehicle operators conducted a reconnaissance drive by of the target location. Once the team leaders were back at the staging area individual team assignments were given and several rehearsals were conducted. After performing a final brief back the teams loaded in their assigned vehicles and proceeded to the target location over a predetermined route.

Once at the target location the teams dismounted and proceeded to their areas of responsibility. The Alpha Team was unable to make immediate entry because debris was blocking the stairwell, the Alpha Team notified the Bravo Team of the failed breach. The Bravo Team could not locate an entry point on the 4 side and had to move to the 2 side and then make entry. The Alpha team was able to clear the debris out of the way and breach (Operator Scotina) the second floor apartment and deploy a diversionary device (Sgt. Max). Once inside the apartment was located in the living room was located in a rear bedroom and were also located in the 2nd floor apartment, and was handcuffed Operator O'Leary. was handcuffed by Sgt. Max. Located in the third floor attic apartment was a male subject, young children were also located in the third floor apartment. The basement was cleared by members of both the Bravo and Delta teams; Operators Banosian, Duggan, Shackelford and Kiens cleared the basement and did not locate any further suspects.

After securing the apartment and conducting a secondary search the apartment and the suspects were turned over to Haverhill PD. The team then returned to the staging area and conducted a debrief of the operation and then cleared the scene. The hours of the operation were 0330 - 0730 hours.
