

On Friday August 30, 2013 at approximately 1100 hours the NEMLEC SWAT Team was activated to assist the Methuen Police Department with an armed barricaded suicidal male. The team was instructed to stage at the National Guard Armory on Lowell Street, Methuen. While en route to the staging area I received a phone a phone call from Sqt. Christian Max updating me on the situation.

The Methuen Police Department had responded to **the first** owell Street in regards to a possible suicidal male. Upon the arrival of the first responding patrol officers it was learned from several family members that the subject, **the subject**, **the subject**,

suffers from numerous medical issues and Bipolar Disorder. When had reportedly made threats to harm himself and other family and that he would shoot anyone who approached the house. When had access to a gun safe that contained a .38 caliber handgun, .22 caliber rifle and a 12 gauge shotgun. When had told family members that he had the handgun in his mouth earlier in the morning. When was reportedly alone in the house in a rear bedroom. Methuen PD had been on scene for approximately one hour trying to make contact with when with negative results.

Shortly after arriving at the staging area I learned that the Methuen PD had made contact with and taken him into custody without incident and were transporting him to Holy Family Hospital. A page was sent out at this point canceling all NEMLEC resources responding to the staging area. No formal attendance was taken.
