The RRT officers sealed off the perimeter around the schools while the K-9s and overwatch personnell searched the area around the schools. The SWAT Team simultaneously entered and cleared both schools.

IMAT personnell trained with us, setting up the Command Post for operations near the school complex. IMAT personnel managed communications and logistics for the exercise.

All personnel debriefed the incident afterward. The only major issues we experienced were with communications from within the school. A group of us remained and held a question and answer session and debrief for teachers and administrators from the schools.

The hours of the training were 0730-1230 hrs.

On Wednesday March 20, 2013 the NEMLEC SWAT Team held its monthly training at the Middlesex County Sheriff's Departments Training Academy in Billerica. The days' training was a combined training with the MSO SWAT Team. The training for the day was split into three phases.

The first phase of the training concentrated on team movements through large hallways, stair wells and rooms. Several scenarios based on an armed suspect in a school were set up for the team. These particular scenarios also allowed for the opportunity for both the NEMLEC and MSO teams to integrate and work together.

The second phase of training was a tour of the Billerica House of Correction. This tour allowed the team members to see the inside of the facility and also discuss possible problems and concerns if the team was ever called upon to assist the MSO with a disturbance in the facility.
